22.15 APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS COMMITTEE MEETING

- **Resolved to approve Minutes of the previous Committee meeting on 28 February 2022**

22.16 TO RECEIVE NEW NATIONAL OR LOCAL JUBILEE RELATED INFORMATION

-It was confirmed that Congham Parish Council was organising its own local event on the Saturday.

22.17 Co-option

22.18 FINANCE

The Clerk confirmed that the grant had been received.

22.19 PUBLICITY

Cllr Shepherdly thanked the Committee for the feedback on the banners and posters, the consensus of opinion had been Option 2, Cllr S Coleman would provide costings on sizes. The programme would be sent to the Village Link. The Facebook event page was getting good responses, although no information on the planting appeared to have been sent out yet to families. Cllr Boldero would speak to the school, but a number of staff were off with Covid. Cllr S Coleman said the events would be promoted on the FOB group Facebook.

22.20 EVENT PROJECT PLANNING

Queen's Canopy Tree Planting – 19 March 2022 10.00am-Noon – Hudson Fen

The free saplings had arrived, the delivery was twice the amount expected. The area had been rotovated, leaving distinct paths as requested by the Trust. HUFL and the Trust agreed to an opening directly off the recreation ground. The Clerk was asked to approach Direct Plants to source Sweet Chestnut and Medlars. Cllr S Coleman said that she would bring the information panels to set up in the gazebo on the day. The Committee inspected the jubilee pencils and notepads from Baker Ross, and any not used on the day would be made into goody bags for the picnic.

Flagpole and Flag Raising: 2 June 2022 - 11.30am - Triangle Green

The Clerk confirmed that the charge for planning would be £240.00.

- **Resolved to move the event from Sunday to the morning of 2 June, so the flag could fly for the Jubilee weekend.**

String Quartet Recital: 2 June 2022 7.00pm- 9.15pm - St Botolph's Church

Cllr S Coleman said that the tickets would be £12.00 (£10.00 for FOB members). A ticket line with an answering machine had been set up for bookings. The ticket price would include the concert, Jubilee punch and canapes during the interval and it was agreed that drinks would be available after the concert and beacon lighting. Doors would start with a welcome at 7.00pm, the first performance to start at 7.15p till 8.00 pm, a 30-minute interval resuming at 8.30pm till 9.15pm, whereby people could move outside for the lighting if they wished. Cllr Israel to liaise with Kavolini for invoice and programme.

Beacon Lighting: 2 June 2022 9.30-9.45pm St Botolph's Church

The Beacon lighting had been registered on the national map. No bugler had been sourced as yet, but the Church was making inquiries on the Committee's behalf.

Exhibition and Art Display: 2-5 June 2022 – St Botolph's Church

Committee noted that funding was now in place to provide groups with a small grant to help fund materials. There would be 7 pieces of art linking back to the Queen's life on the theme "Fit for a Queen". Groups confirmed so far included Grimston Art Club, Holly Meadows School, Flower Arrangers x2, Parish Council had been confirmed. Mrs Roper would discuss with the WI and the Crafters.

The Great Pt78 Car Treasure Hunt: 3 June 2022, 1.30 pm -3.30pm – Village Hall

It was agreed to add "car" to the title to ensure residents knew it was not a walking event. It was proposed that the ticket price be reduced to £5.00, the lottery grant could be used to cover the shortfall if necessary, to be confirmed with Cllr Fraser. It was noted that the limit was 20 cars, which meant a maximum of 80 people or a minimum of 40. Cllr Fraser had sourced a wooden spoon for the losing team.

Afternoon Family Picnic: 4 June 2022 – 3.00pm- 6.00pm – Hudson Fen

The Committee had agreed to allow a mini-funfair and bouncy castle. The arrangement would be that there would be no charge to the Council, but families could purchase a wristband for each child for unlimited goes, subject to satisfactory insurance and supervision. The Committee requested clarification on the wristbands. Cllr Shepherdly reported that along with Holly Meadows FC, the Cricket Club had asked to be involved in an activity rather than a stall, this was agreed. Hufl was having a stone picking event on 18 May. Cllr Boldero would talk to the Methodist Chapel about a stall.

Evening Live Band on the Fen: 4 June 2022 –6.00m-10.00 pm – Hudson Fen

The Committee discussed event setup. It was confirmed that Kev's Kafé would operate throughout the event.
